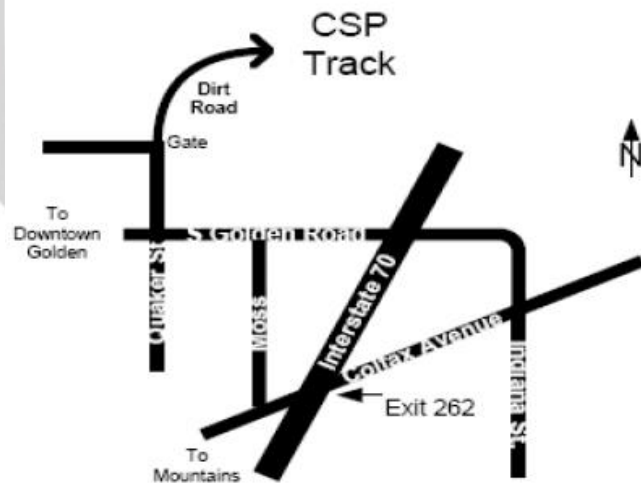
Directions

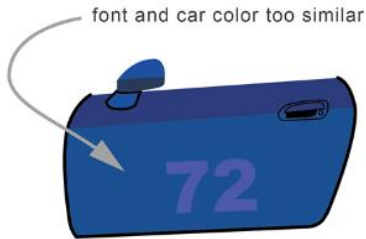
A lunch break will be provided if time allows it. Afternoon schedule may vary.

Map to site

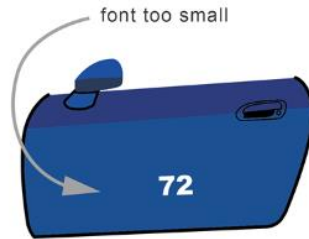




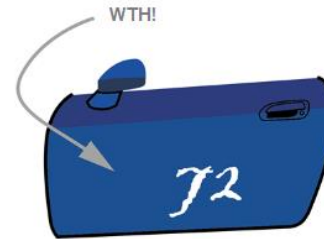
